SUNSET SAFARI

The lakes in the tributaries of the Amazon are unique ecosystems, with a profusion of great variety of wildlife. From lake to lake there are many differences, depending on the size of each and the type of forest surrounding it. In high water we have choose the Saraiva Lake: and low water Gamboa lake located in the state Loreto Peru.

Includes: river transportation in native motor driven boats for 5 – 18 persons, professional Spanish speaking guide, flashlights, refreshments.

Recommendations: pants and long-sleeved short, repellent, comfortable closed shoes.

PUERTO NARIÑO/HANDICRAFTS

A complete run on the great Amazon River from Leticia where you can visit and admire diverse ecosystems. We will be able to appreciate the world's largest lotus, the Victoria Regia. Upriver we will find a community of Tikuna native tribesmen: Macedonia, a perfect place to appreciate the handicrafts designed and elaborated by the inhabitants, among which stand out tapestries and dolls made of yanchama (tree bark), beautiful accessories elaborated from seeds and feathers, spectacular carrying bags woven with chambira, and a great variety of objects such as pensadores, walking sticks, belt buckles and necklaces elaborated with palosangre (*brosimum rubescens* taub), a very fine type of wood and of great cultural value for many of the native communities of the region. Any of these handicrafts would make the perfect gift to take to our loved ones. Next comes a trip to Puerto Nariño, the second largest municipality in the department; a very typical village inhabited by natives and colonos (settlers) (denominated the manger of Colombia).

Includes: river transportation in native motor driven boats for 5 – 28 persons, entry lotus nature reserve, visit Macedonian Ticuna indigenous community, entry Natutama Museum, professional Spanish speaking guide, refreshments, typical lunch.

Recommendations: shoes appropriate for walking; repellent; lightweight, light-colored (green or blue) clothing; sun block, hat, sunglasses, cash in small Colombian denomination for souvenir shopping, waterproof.

NATURAL RESERVE CERCA VIVA

After a brief trip by car, we will reach a very special destination: the Cerca Viva reserve, a model of man-nature interrelationships and diversity of agro-forestry. Here we will walk the eco route “the dynamic of the jungle” with a space of interrelationship and environmental education which brings visitors close to and illustrates the dynamic of the forest (flora and fauna). During the trip it is very likely to be able to observe an incredible variety of fabulous insects, distinct classes of birds, boquiblanco monkeys, poison frogs, serpents, guaras and squirrels, among others. While traveling the paths of the Saltarines, the Boquiblanco, la Quebrada, la Siringa and Ranas, the visitor comprehends the need to conserve and manage sustainably the forest resources so that our descendants may also enjoy this wonderful ecosystem: the Amazon jungles.

Includes: land transportation by automobile, helmet, vest, entry to the reserve, professional Spanish speaking guide, refreshments or fruit in harvest

Recommendations: repellent, lightweight, light-colored (green or blue) clothing; shoes appropriate for walking, sun block, hat

THE ART OF NATIVE FISHING

The Amazon jungle is an exuberant region because of the abundant rain it receives all year long. The Amazon is the largest river in the world and its basin forms the greatest tropical rain forest on the planet. The Amazon has extraordinary natural wealth, and with more than 100 tributary rivers, there is a biodiversity of fish, among which is found the pirarucu, the largest fresh-water fish in the world.

We will enjoy a day of adventure with native-style fishing with low ecological impact; we can try our hand with the calm of a big fish, and even stop to fish for piranha with a balsa rod and 3-pronged Indian harpoon, fish for bagre (catfish), dorado, sardines, etc.

Includes: river transportation in typical canoes with capacity for 6 persons, skilled fisherman Spanish speaking native guide, bait, arrows, refreshments, waterproof.

Recommendations: sun block, lightweight clothing, tennis shoes or wet shoes, hat, sunglasses, repellent.

NATURAL RESERVE ISLA DE LOS MICOS

Dare to live a new adventure in Isla de los Micos Natural Reserve with 450 hectares, located 35 km. from Leticia and 45 minutes upriver on the Amazon. Discover the paths of elevated bridges from which the ecological and cultural environment of the island are interpreted; learn about the history of the monkeys on the island and the different species found there while the native Indian ecological guide instructs you about their behavior, social organization, reproduction and feeding habits.

Includes: river transportation, entry to the community, professional Spanish speaking guide, refreshments.

Recommendations: shoes appropriate for walking, repellent, lightweight, light-colored (green or blue) clothing, hat, sun block, cash in small Colombian denomination for souvenir shopping, waterproof.

Duration of the hike: approx. 45 minutes

BIRD WATCHING

Colombia has the world's richest bird population, with more than 800 different species of birds found in its Amazon jungle. On this excursion we will have the opportunity to admire and appreciate the wonders of nature, exotic bird specimens and some endemic ones such as *Brotogeris versicolurus*, the *Tyrannus albogularis*, *Piuri - Crax globulosa* and others. Travel in the Amazon is gratifying, and accompanied by an expert in this field, you will receive an introduction to the magical world of ornithology. Delight yourself with the concert and color of unimaginable species during this walk through the Amazon jungle.

The activity will take place in two areas, depending on the season of high waters or low waters.

One of the options is in the area of La Milagrosa, which includes an agreeable walk of approximately 2 hours through small villages.

As an alternative, 25 minutes from Leticia navigating on the Amazon, we find ourselves on a small river called Gamboa, with great scenic beauty. On it we find a variety of mysterious and exotic bird species of the Amazon ecosystems. During this trip by typical motor driven boat one navigates around the island for approximately 2 hours to appreciate the beauty of the environment and enjoy the song of the birds.

Includes: river transportation on motor driven boats with capacity for 5 – 18 persons (if the excursion is to Isla Gamboa), specialized guide, binoculars, bird chart, refreshments, snack.

Recommendations: pants and long-sleeved, light-colored (blue or green) cotton short, shoes appropriate for walking, repellent, hat, sun block, waterproof.

NATURAL RESERVE EWARE AGAPE

Eware – Agape is a heavenly place located in the Amazon jungle only 20 minutes by land transport from the urban perimeter of Leticia. We will learn about the history of this reserve created by the Capuchin friars minor during the entrance walk, then go on the exquisite “Asai Path” which has a great variety of flora and solid ground type forest; we will get to know how the natives fertilize the land for cultivation of their chagras (farm plots) and we will have an encounter with the tiny Ticuna Indian community of San Pedro, where we will enjoy a short typical dance and see how they work with plant fibers to elaborate basketry and handicrafts.

Includes: Land transport by automobile (taxi or van), entry to the reserve, professional Spanish speaking guide, hydration (1 water and 1 soda), snack (1 cereal bar, 1 bag of chips and 1 soda), Asai Path, entry to San Pedro community, typical dance, hand-crafted bracelet made of plant fibers, showing of chagras with manioc and pineapple cultivation.

Recommendations: repellent, lightweight, light-colored (green or blue) clothing, boots, sun block, hat, rain gear.

HUITOTO INDIAN COMMUNITY (Typical Dances)

Traveling 11 kms. from Leticia by land, one finds the Huitoto Indian community. Here in the Maloka (sacred place) where the headman and his family live, heirs of ceremonial races and mambeadero oral tradition, the welfare of the tribesmen is balanced and planned. Ceremonies and rituals of interrelationship with the humanized jungle are celebrated, giving example of cosmogony and the degree of intellectual development of these millennial cultures. We will appreciate some examples of different ceremonial dances.

Includes: land transportation, typical dances, Indian guide, refreshments.

Recommendations: pants and long-sleeved shirt, comfortable shoes, repellent, cash in small Colombian denomination to buy handicrafts.

PUERTO NARIÑO/ISLA MICOS (monkey feeding)/MACEDONIA

A complete run on the great Amazon River from Leticia where you can visit and admire diverse ecosystems such as Victoria Regia Reserve where you will appreciate the world's largest lotus. Later, you will visit the attractive Isla Micos (Monkey Island), with an extension of 450 hectares where you will get in direct contact with the dominate specie of the island, el Saimirí or Squirrel Monkey, learn about the history of the monkeys on the island and the different species found there while the native Indian ecological guide instructs you about their behavior, social organization, reproduction and feeding habits. You will be fascinated by the fauna and flora of the environment. Upriver we will find a community of Tikuna native tribesmen: Macedonia, a perfect place to appreciate the handicrafts designed and elaborated by the inhabitants, among which stand out tapestries and dolls made of yanchama (tree bark), beautiful accessories elaborated from seeds and feathers, spectacular carrying bags woven with chambira, and a great variety of objects such as pensadores, walking sticks, belt buckles and necklaces elaborated with palosangre (*brosimum rubescens* taub), a very fine type of wood and of great cultural value for many of the native communities of the region. Any of these handicrafts would make the perfect gift to take to our loved ones. Next comes a trip to Puerto Nariño, the second largest municipality in the department; a very typical village inhabited by natives and colonos (settlers) (denominated the manger of Colombia).

AMAZON WORLD - JUNGLE FULL DAY

The Amazon World Ecological Park is the first and only environmental education center in the municipality of Leticia. It is a space to see Amazonian plants, learn about traditional and medicinal uses while enjoying an interactive, fun and unforgettable experience learning about the biodiversity of the Amazon, ecology, agritourism and much more. It is the first visit you should do in the Amazon. The visit includes 4 routes accompanied by a native environmental interpreter:

1. MEDICINAL PLANTS (The largest organized collection of Amazonian plants in the department, 6 pedagogical stations and Amazon Tea tasting)
2. NATURAL PRODUCTS (Meet native plants and fruits used in sustainable development systems in the Amazon, sustainable production processes and environmental education)
3. CULTURAL VILLA (Have fun with bow and arrow, and darts with blowguns throwing activities)
4. AQUARIUS (Meet the piranhas and many other Amazon fish)

At noon the traditional lunch will be taken: Patarasca: local fish cooked in charcoal wrapped in bijao leaves, accompanied with native ingredients such as farinã, tapioca, tucupí pepper, rice, organic salad, and natural juice. Then, jungle walk on a beautiful hour and a half trail.

Includes: land transportation by car, entrance to the Amazon World Ecological Park, 4 eco routes, 1 bottle of water, lunch and jungle trail.

Recommendations: repellent, light colored clothes, appropriate walking shoes, sunscreen, hat.

Note: People with alcohol or drug influence will not be accepted.

VISIT HUITOTO MALOKA (INDIGENOUS VILLAGE)

This interesting activity includes a run of approximately 15 minutes from the urban part of Leticia to our departure point, from which we will take a walk that will last about 45 minutes. Our foray into this ecosystem will be made over cleared paths. During our walk we will learn about the quality of the land, the forest dynamic, and identify some species of trees like the rubber tree, the history and method of extraction of rubber in the Amazon.

Once we have been instructed about the domestic and ritual space in the village, the Shaman will invite us to the mambadero, the village's sacred site, to start the talk where he will show us the entheogens used by the Huitotos in their daily life and rituals. This talk will last an hour with space for questions.

During a short tour around the maloca accompanied by the Shaman, he will show us the yagé or soul liana, tobacco plants, coca leaf cultivation and other plants used in the Huitoto ethno-botany.

Includes: land transfer, professional guide, hydration (1 bottle of water), forest tour on firm soil, entrance to the Huitoto maloca and talk with the Shaman.

Recommendations: long pants and long-sleeved shirt, comfortable shoes, insect repellent, sun block, hat for the sun, rubber boots, and rain poncho.

Observation: Reservations for this activity must be made a minimum of half a day in advance.

NATURAL RESERVE MARASHA – Perú

A Refuge made out of natural conditions whose typical architecture of Malocas designed and built under the rules of environmental preservation of biodiversity. We offer visitors a placid stay so they can relax and recreate their minds coexisting with the exotic nature. A 45 minutes journey to an hour to the facilities of the hostel Marasha mark the prelude to the magical feeling of life that only MARASHA can offer.

The walk through a broad path into the jungle with its huge trees and varied vegetation can be recorded best, by photographic images or video, also contemplating the landscape with its fauna species such as monkeys, butterflies and multicolored birds.

Includes: land transfer, professional guide, snack, boating, Sport fishing, ecological walk, lunch, rest area, hydration, local guide.

Recommendations: long pants and long-sleeved shirt, comfortable shoes, insect repellent, sun block, hat for the sun, rubber boots, and rain poncho.

NIGHT WALK THROUGH THE JUNGLE – OMAGUA OR AGAPE RESERVE

The Amazon jungle has a great extension of solid ground which corresponds to more than three quarters of the Amazon River basin; this is the perfect opportunity to get acquainted with the jungle setting in the night hours.

We will cover 10 kilometers departing from the urban part of Leticia to enter the Omagua reserve where we will visit areas known as floodable terraces and solid ground forest, accompanied by a guide who will emphasize the observation of minor nocturnal fauna (insects, birds, mammals, amphibians and reptiles), and we will see the phenomenon of bio-luminescence, practice identifying jungle sounds and test our nighttime senses of touch, smell and sound.

Includes: land transfer, professional guide, hydration (1 bottle of water), flashlight, walk through solid ground forest, entrance to the Reserve.

Recommendations: long pants and long-sleeved shirt, comfortable shoes, insect repellent, rubber boots, and rain poncho.

Observation: Reservations must be made a minimum of half a day in advance.

AMAZON WORLD + HUITOTO COMMUNITY

The Amazon World Ecological Park is the first and only environmental education center in the municipality of Leticia. It is a space to see Amazonian plants, learn about traditional and medicinal uses while enjoying an interactive, fun and unforgettable experience learning about the biodiversity of the Amazon, ecology, agrotourism and much more. It is the first visit you should do in the Amazon. The visit includes 4 routes accompanied by a native environmental interpreter:

1. MEDICINAL PLANTS (The largest organized collection of Amazonian plants in the department, 6 pedagogical stations and Amazon Tea tasting)
2. NATURAL PRODUCTS (Meet native plants and fruits used in sustainable development systems in the Amazon, sustainable production processes and environmental education)
3. CULTURAL VILLA (Have fun with bow and arrow, and darts with blowguns throwing activities)
4. AQUARIUS (Meet the piranhas and many other Amazon fish)

At noon the traditional lunch will be taken: Patarasca: local fish cooked in charcoal wrapped in bijao leaves, accompanied with native ingredients such as faríña, tapioca, tucupí pepper, rice, organic salad, and natural juice. Then walk to the Huitoto community located 300 meters from the Park, talk with the traditional wiseman of the indigenous community in the maloca, about their culture and customs.

Includes: land transportation by car, entrance to the Amazon World Ecological Park, 4 eco routes, 1 bottle of water, lunch and visit to indigenous community.

Recommendations: repellent, light colored clothes, appropriate walking shoes, sunscreen, hat.

Note: People with alcohol or drug influence will not be accepted.

TRADITIONAL TOURS

Tour by bus from the hotel along the Leticia – Tarapacá Highway project, accompanied by a professional guide who he will teach us about the existence of various indigenous communities. Along the route we will come into contact with the inhabitants, who will also offer their handicrafts in wood or plant fibers (Yanchama, Chambira). The panoramic tour is 24 kilometers long (round trip) in which you can learn about the different natural reserves, ethnic groups and most importantly, visit and have direct contact with some of the traditional houses, thus offering a real participatory experience.

Includes: Land transport by bus, professional guide, hydration (1 bottle of water), stops in community at Kilometers 6 and 11.

Recommendations: Long pants and long-sleeved shirt, insect repellent, sunblock, hat for the sun, rain poncho.

Level of Difficulty: I

AMAZON JUNGLE EXPERIENCE AGAPE/LAGOS/ BIODIVERSITY

During this activity you will have a great Amazon experience, connecting and getting acquainted with an ample biodiversity of scenes, starting with a walk through the dense jungle with its huge quantity of sounds, some species of primates, a variety in the etymological field, to arrive three hours later at the community of San Pedro to get to know a little of the Ticuna ethnic group, their customs and way of life; to continue our adventure going through the settings of ravines and lakes which form part of the great ecosystem of the lakes of Yahuarkaka (Zapatero, Sicurishu and Camboia II Lakes), which will fascinate you with their magic and the rich variety of birds. You can swim in the ample lakes, and why not? – with a little luck – spot some dolphins during the tour. At the Flor de Loto Reserve a delicious lunch typical of the region awaits us. You can also do some small-scale sport fishing and savor the landscape in comfortable hammocks.

Includes: Overland transport in motorized vehicle (taxi or van), entrances to the Ágape and Flor de Loto Reserves, entrance to the de San Pedro community, hydration (2 waters and 1 soft drink), snack (1 pack of soda crackers), professional guide, demonstration of cultivation of family agricultural plots, small-scale fishing, swimming in lakes, tour in typical canoes with life jackets, typical lunch (fried rice, fish cracklings, ripe plantain), rest stop in hammocks.

Recommendations: Insect repellent, lightweight, light-colored clothing (green and blue), boots, sunblock, hat or head covering, raingear, bathing suit, change of clothing, ability to swim.

AMAZON SUNSET

Sundown in the Amazon is full of magic. When night falls, the jungle awakens and delights our senses with wonderful sounds and energetic night life. You can see insects that glow in the dark and listen to the jungle calls under a beautiful starry sky.

We begin the tour by boat through the lakes where if nature allows, we will see pink dolphins and the return of the birds to their roosts in Yahuaracaca. When night falls, we will penetrate deeper into the flooded jungle of Lake Zapatero and, as explorers, we can appreciate the treetops, the beautiful Renaco – known as the tree that walks – and many nocturnal animals that will show us a different way of life.

BRAZIL'S DOLPHINS OBSERVATION (Therezinha)

This activity gives us the opportunity to experience the wonderful way of life of the riverside villages, which have unrivaled natural treasures around them; the exotic wealth of the jungle with all its medicinal plants, the colossal and imposing trees like the Ceiba and other elements, make of the Brazilian's Amazon a paradise. The adventure begins with a 40-minutes boat ride, until you reach the Solimoes River (Amazon River in Brazil), and one of its small towns, Villa de Therezinha. There; the locals welcome and introduce the traveler in the next experience to live, starting with a path that will gradually enter the jungle, to listen to the Saimiri Monkeys and delight the sight with the colors of the butterflies, until get to the dazzling and mystical Lake Caiau. In typical boats known as small-small, part of this wonderful lake will be covered, which, within its almost 8 kilometers long, offers the opportunity to practice piranha fishing, and if nature allows it, to appreciate or listen to the huge Pirarucú (largest scale fish in the world).

The lake is home of many pink dolphins, which come out to browse when travelers arrive. This encounter with nature marks the end of the journey to return to Leticia with the best memories.

It is the new Barranquilla's quintessential tourist attraction. There, you will be able to enjoy the Caimán del Río Food Market, the first with an open kitchen layout on the Magdalena River, where you will enjoy the coast's ancestral food. We then continue to the monument called the "Window to the World," considered the country's tallest monument, where you will see a fabulous gallery of images of the city.

Lastly, we will stop at one of the city's best malls, where you will have time to go shopping.

A basic museum brings us information about the culture of the Tayronas, who inhabited this zone (700 years BC – 1600 years BC). This place is framed by the exotic vegetation, mild weather and abundant wildlife.

Here, we will enjoy a day filled with a colorful landscape and magical walkways. The DON DIEGO river runs straight from the snow peaks. To take a bath there is very relaxing and comforting. During the journey, we can see squirrels, iguanas, some species of birds that come to feed in strategic sites designed specially for them as well as exotic flowers that grow in this zone (birds of paradise among others).

The Wayúu culture, settlers of this gentle region whose inhabitants revere the zone as a sacred place, is firmly rooted in its traditions. Legend tells us that when a Wayúu dies, his soul inhabits this territory; therefore they care for and respect the land. You will visit el Faro and the Pilón de Azúcar, active participants of the exotic scenery, which you can access them by enjoyable hikes, a dare for those who are lovers of scenery and the challenges of nature.

One hundred twenty kilometers from Santa Marta we find the Los Flamencos Sanctuary of Fauna and Flora, located between the Caribbean Sea and the Desert or dry forest of the Guajira, a small area of coastal lagoons fed by streams where the birds that give the name to this sanctuary feed. The graceful flamingos and the majestic colors of their plumage are the principal attraction, which despite its reduced extension, is considered one of the richest protected zones in variety of resident and migratory aquatic birds.

Forty minutes away is Riohacha, capital of the Guajira, located on the Caribbean Sea next to the desert. This city where the Ranchería River flows into the sea permits the visitor to connect with the legacy of the Wayúu natives, manifest in their traditions and artisanal crafts, among which colorful tote bags stand out. We will do a tour of the city visiting the Plaza de Padilla, monument to Francisco the Man, the tourist pier, Cathedral of Our Lady of the Remedies, the house of Gabriel García Márquez's grandparents, park of the cannons, the viewpoint and residential neighborhoods.

During the excursion we can observe the mountainous scenery of the foothills of the Sierra, coffee plantations and exotic flowers surrounded by an incipient fog that enhances the mystery created by the Tayrona culture, the picturesque life of its inhabitants and residents full of harmony and a sense of belonging to the land that predates the highest mountain range of Colombia, tropical flowers that perfume the paths and adorn the dwellings and roads. Outstanding are the heliconias, ginger or maracas, anthuriums, orchids and red gingers.

Minca confirms the Colombian seal of the coffee-growing country. Its coffee plantations are another of its forest charms. We'll have the chance to learn about the process of coffee production at a local farm and savor this delicious beverage.

Finally, we will take a 30 to 45-minute walk to enjoy a swim in the refreshing "Pozo Azul" (blue pool).

We begin our tour visiting the train station. From there we will do a walking tour to the places related to the life and work of the author of One Hundred Years of Solitude. We'll visit the sculpture of Remedios, La Bella (Remedios, the Beautiful); the Maria Montessori School where the writer learned his first lessons; the Commissary of the United Fruit Company; the House-Museum of Gabo and the House of the Telegrapher.
