



EDUCATION PILLAR

Decameron Pre-School:

We provide comprehensive care in the areas of education, nutrition, social-emotional development, and recreation to 50 children from the Barú communities, with the goal of preparing them for entry into formal education.



We implemented this program in partnership with the Santo Domingo Foundation at the Barbacoas Ecological Institute Educational Foundation (FEIEB), under the motto:

“We enroll families and provide them with the tools to implement appropriate parenting practices and support their children in their transition to formal education.”

This is complemented by teacher training, health workshops, and ongoing support for families.

Early Childhood Care – Don Jaca (Santa Marta) And Boquilla (Cartagena):

In partnership with the ICBF (Colombian Institute of Family Welfare) and early childhood operators in Don Jaca (Santa Marta) and Boquilla (Cartagena), we provide physical spaces for comprehensive care focused on education, nutrition, and recreation, aimed at pregnant women, nursing mothers, and children aged 0 to 5 who are not served by institutional programs such as CDIs (Child Development Centers) or community homes provided by the ICBF.

In 2025, we served 45 families in the Don Jaca community and 98 in La Boquilla, providing in-home support and weekly meetings for educational, physical, and cognitive development activities, as well as workshops for families. We also delivered a monthly food basket and items from our donation project.

We also commemorated special occasions such as Breastfeeding Week, Children's Day, and Christmas. Finally, we provided a nutritional supplement from the Decameron Foundation, distributed three times a year to the Don Jaca community.



Reading Project “El Jardín De Las Palabras” (“The Words Garden”) San Andrés:

The objective of this project is to create spaces for reading mediation to help improve reading fluency and comprehension, using tools that promote the enjoyment of the reading process as an essential part of overall development.

This project benefits 18 children from the Red Ground community (Las Tablitas) in San Andrés, and is developed in partnership with Mamaroja Company, an organization recognized for leading the San Andres Book Festival.
